REPORTING TO PARENTS

You can keep track of your child's progress in school by logging on to Family Access. This online communication tool gives you a real time look at the teacher's record book. Parents can see how their child/ren are performing against the learning standards. The first parent conferences are held in the fall. These conferences are intended to give parents an opportunity to meet with the teacher and set academic goals. Parent logins for Family Access are available in the school office. Parent conferences will also be held in late March/early April to discuss your child's academic progress. Parents are invited to contact the teacher to arrange a conference at any time regarding their child's progress.

SIGNING IN

All non-students and non-employees must sign in when entering the building. When signing in, the visitor will receive a tag indicating they have registered as a visitor/volunteer. This includes parents picking students up near the pod classroom doors inside the building at the end of the school day.

SAFE WALKING ROUTES

Walking to school each day can be part of a good exercise program that keeps your child healthy, fit, and ready to learn. Eagle Creek provides families with the following suggested safe walking routes. The walk route plan has been developed based on traffic patterns and traffic controls such as crosswalks, traffic lights/stop signs, and adult crossing guard locations. Students who are walking to school are to use the concrete walkways and refrain from walking on the road, parking lots, grass areas, shortcuts, or neighbors' property. No walkers are to enter or leave the school by using the driveway where cars enter and exit.
