

Walk Area Designations 2014-16

School Districts are required to review their existing walk area designations every 2 years.

All students living with-in a one-road-mile area are considered to be living in the school's safe walk area unless hazardous conditions result in portions of the one-road-mile area being designated as non-safe walk areas.

Curlew School Transportation Department feels that the one-road-mile area which lies on the far side of Boulder Creek road should be designated as a non-safe walk area due to the hazards associated with Boulder Creek Rd.

Specifically, hazards along the stretch of Boulder Creek road which connects to Curlew School Road include:

- Frequent lumber, logging, and construction trucks
- Limited Sight Distance due to the curve of the road
- Consistent speeding along Boulder Creek Rd.
- No Curbs or sidewalks
- No shoulder along one side resulting in students walking with their back to traffic
- Blockage of the existing shoulder by parked cars and snow in the winter
- There is an extreme lack of foot traffic along Boulder Creek Rd resulting in drivers not expecting or looking for pedestrians
